

AIMS Caseload Tracker

The AIMS Caseload Tracker is a secure web-based registry for managing behavioral health caseloads in integrated care settings. It is used alongside your Electronic Health Record to provide powerful tracking and reporting functions:

- Provides reminders for patient follow-up
- Identifies patients not improving to prioritize for treatment adjustment or psychiatric case review
- Displays progress over time for individual patient symptoms using the [PHQ-9](#) and [GAD-7](#)
- Produces caseload reports summarizing trends in depression symptom scores and dates of contact
- Calculates real-time statistics like caseload size, length of time in treatment and frequency of visits
- Facilitates reporting on the [HEDIS Depression Remission and Response measure](#)
- Tracks minutes of service delivered each month to facilitate [CPT](#) and [CoCM Code](#) billing

2021 Pricing

Health care organizations can license the AIMS Caseload Tracker from the University of Washington for an annual fee that covers data hosting, support and maintenance. A single license covers use of the software at multiple clinic locations as long as Protected Health Information (PHI) can appropriately be viewed and shared between clinics; PHI under a single license will never be shared outside the licensing organization. Users typically include behavioral health providers, care managers, psychiatry providers, behavioral health supervisors and other administrators.

The AIMS Center offers discounted pricing to all providers in Washington State and to qualified safety net organizations, including but not limited to: FQHCs, RHCs, CCBHCs, CMHCs, Critical Access Hospitals, Sole Community Hospitals, IHS and HCH Grantees.
